

Returned Peace Corps Volunteers of New Jersey (RPCV-NJ)

National Peace Corps Association (NPCA) Liaison Responsibility Final, approved by Board June 1, 2013

The President of the RPCV-NJ Board usually will have this responsibility, which is to serve as a liaison between the RPCV-NJ and the National Peace Corps Association (NPCA). The goal is to coordinate information and activities between the national and state level wherever this would advance the priorities of both groups.

This responsibility includes:

- Being the main point of contact for communications from the NPCA and ensuring that relevant information is shared with the appropriate member(s) of the RPCV-NJ Board.
- Encouraging participation by RPCV-NJ members in NPCA events/initiatives (e.g. the annual National Day of Action).
- Providing support to RPCV-NJ Committee members in their activities that support NPCA initiatives (e.g. Advocacy, World Wise Schools, etc.)
- Working with the NPCA to ensure their support for RPCV-NJ initiatives as needed (e.g. exchange of data base information, advocacy materials, etc.)
- Preparing the annual NPCA Group Renewal Application
